ClubsNSW Club Life articles Club Bingo and Charitable Housie

Article by Senior Policy Officer - Gambling Daniel Mitchell "Recent audits conducted by the NSW Office of Liquor, Gaming and Racing (OLGR) have revealed that some clubs are not always fully aware of the legislative requirements with respect to conducting Club Bingo and Charitable Housie, which can result in inadvertent breaches of the legislation.

It is important that clubs are aware that Charitable Housie and Club Bingo each have their own separate set of regulatory requirements. Unintentional mistakes often occur when Charitable Housie rules are applied to Club Bingo or vice versa. For example, clubs should ensure the maximum ticket price for Club Bingo is five cents per game or 30 cents for a sheet of six games and the maximum ticket price for Charitable House is 40 cents per game or \$2.40 for a sheet of six games.

Where third-party providers conduct Club Bingo or Charitable House on behalf of the club, the club is responsible for ensuring compliance with the relevant legislative requirements. Failure to comply with the legislative requirements could result in the Regulator undertaking compliance action against the club. Clubs are advised to conduct proper due diligence on third-party services providers to satisfy themselves that the services offered comply with the legislation."

C Keno Licence Renewed

Article by Media & Communications Manager Carissa Simons "The NSW Government has granted ClubKeno Holdings and Tabcorp a new licence to operate the game of Keno exclusively in NSW licensed venues through to 2050.

The extension of the licence is the final commitment in the 2010 Memorandum of Understanding with ClubsNSW to be delivered by the NSW Coalition. ClubsNSW welcomes the licence extension and the certainty it provides clubs about the long term future of their game.

The game of Keno was originally brought to NSW by ClubsNSW in 1989 with the game going live in 1991, for the benefit of ClubsNSW member clubs. Nowadays, Keno is available in over 1,800 NSW clubs and hotels and last year alone made nine players instant millionaires.

The announcement follows the recent re-branding of Keno and improvements to customer experience through enhancements to game screens. Self-service terminals, game cards and signage across the eastern seaboard. This rebranding is reflective of the contemporary, fun and social game Keno is.ClubKENO holdings Pty Ltd, a subsidiary of ClubsNSw, is a joint holder of the Keno licence in NSW with Tabcorp, which operates the game of Keno under a management agreement."
